In July 2010 the school received an interim assessment by Ofsted, stating that because our pupils' academic performance had been sustained, the next Ofsted inspection would be deferred.



We know that children achieve far more if home and school work closely together.

For this reason, there are many opportunities throughout the year for parents and staff to get together. These include an annual 'Meet the Teacher', a welcome meeting for new parents showing an interest in accessing a Nursery place for their child, meetings to explain reading and phonics and the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. A welcome meeting is also held for parents as their children move into main school. Formal parent's evenings are held twice a year to discuss progress and a written report is sent out at the end of each year. Parents and carers are invited to open sessions where they have opportunities to work alongside their child.

Parents are welcome to make additional appointments with staff at any time during the year, should they have any concerns or need further information.

Every term we produce newsletters with news about recent achievements, information on future events and other relevant information. Curriculum sheets outlining the topic and the work to be covered are issued each term.

Fun social events for the whole family are organised throughout the year, including Harvest Festival, Christingle service at St Lawrence's Church, Christmas Concerts, Family Assemblies, Fun Day and Sports Day.









Behaviour

We firmly believe that children need to be in an environment where they feel happy and safe, and above all where they can trust and respect the people around them. We work closely with Parents to ensure this, as it is essential if children are to learn effectively and develop a responsible attitude to others.

Clearly defined rules and expectations contribute to such an environment and we have established **6 Golden Rules** to help our children to see themselves and each other in a positive way.

Curriculum

Here at Bushfield Infants we provide a broad and balanced curriculum designed to provide rich and exciting learning experiences to meet the needs of all pupils. We have designed a truly creative curriculum where children can learn through first-hand experiences, and where learning is purposeful and meaningful to the children. Pupils are consistently encouraged to be confident, curious and independent and a wide range of skills are taught to promote continued learning into the future.

Within the nursery where we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, we provide a stimulating and safe environment for children to explore, investigate, practise skills and develop emotionally, physically and intellectually.

We have a dedicated Learning Mentor who can offer valuable support to both children and their families.





Extra Curricular Activities

Out of school hours, pupils are encouraged to participate in a variety of social activities which foster the school's involvement in the wider community. We have close links with our Consortium schools in particular with Brumby Juniors and our local pre-school providers.

all taking place after school.








Core Values

Special Educational Needs

For those children with special educational needs, Bushfield Road Infant School is committed to inclusion and to supporting children's rights to equal access. Through early and continuous assessment, we identify individual needs and provide appropriate support and interventions to meet these needs. The school works closely with a range of different agencies to ensure all children with SEN receive the best possible education.

In addition, the school fully subscribes to the Disability and Equality Act 2010 with arrangements for the admission of pupils with disabilities following the North Lincolnshire Authority guidelines. The first point of contact is always to arrange an appointment with the Headteacher to view the school and discuss admission arrangements.
