LUNCHES

North Lincolnshire Council continue to offer free school meals to Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils, however if you have chosen to provide a packed lunch please be aware that we do not allow sweets in lunch boxes. Anything from the biscuit shelf is fine i.e. kit-kat etc, but please do not send children with bars of chocolate, sweets or fizzy drinks.
