- Phase 1 Phonics creating sounds, listening for rhyme and alliteration.

Understanding of the World

- Looking at similarities and differences between superheroes.
- Talking about our favourite superheroes.
- Finding out about Shrove Tuesday, Mother's day and Easter.
- Using computers to play age appropriate games.

Physical Development

- Taking part in Mini Kicks sessions
- Moving in different ways negotiating space.
- Developing co-ordination and balance skills.
- Developing ball skills.
- Holding a pencil correctly and using a pencil with increased control.

Maths

- Counting to 10 and beyond.
- Recognising and beginning to write numerals.
- Giving directions to a Beebot.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Learning and performing Easter songs
- Creating superhero masks, badges and logos.
- Painting superheroes.
- Mother's day and Easter crafts.
