PARENTAL/ADULT RESPONSIBILITY

Please would parents/adults be aware that it is their duty to supervise their children on the playground in the morning, before school is opened at 8.55am.

Please would parents ensure close supervision of their children whilst collecting pupils from the courtyard at the end of the day.

Please help by ensuring the children stay off the grass, the activity trail and garden areas (including the wildlife area outside Mrs Turnbull's class) and by encouraging them to play sensibly whilst waiting to come into school.

Please respect all our outside property by not allowing your child to climb on the benches and chair in our outside classroom or on the 'daisy' table and mushrooms in our quiet area. Thank you for your co-operation.

SAFEGUARDING POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Following our review of the school's safeguarding policy and procedures, the governing body and head teacher have made the following decisions to reduce risks to the children in school.

- Parents should always use the entrance at the back of the school to access the office, between 8.30am and 9.15am, and between 2.45pm and 5.00pm. When the gate to the playground is locked during the school day, parents should only then use the pedestrian path at the front of the school to access the office.
- Parents should press the buzzer and report to the window hatch when entering the office by the front entrance and wait for a member of staff to answer.
- When collecting children from out of school clubs, parents should wait outside the office area at the back of the school and children will be let out to parents via this door.
- Please respect the parking rules outside the school and also resident's access to their properties. Please also respect the need for emergency services to gain easy access to roads and properties. Please do not park in the staff car park unless you have a disabled badge.

- Please note that the School Crossing Patrol lady on the Queensway is retiring this Friday 12th October and at present the position will not be filled so please take care when crossing.
