Computing Curriculum Intent



At Bushfield Road Infant School we use a structured sequence of lessons which enables our teachers to ensure that they have covered the skills required to meet the aims of the national curriculum. Cross-curricular links are also important in supporting other areas of learning. Our lesson plans and resources help children to build on prior knowledge at the same time as introducing new skills and challenges.
