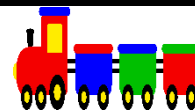


AUTUMN TERM 2020 - RECEPTION



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To recognise and talk about their feelings.
- Share ideas about special people, places and events.
- To learn our class rules.

Physical Development

- To develop an awareness of space.
- To move with imagination, control and co-ordination.
- To hold scissors correctly and begin to cut along lines with increasing control.
- To begin to form recognisable letters.

Communication and Language

- To listen to others in small groups.
- To take turns in conversations.
- To take part in role-play.

Literacy

- Recognise Phase 2 Phonics and begin to read and spell CVC words, such as 'cat'.
- Begin to learn simple keywords for reading books.
- Write their name.
- Read together a variety of nursery rhymes and familiar stories and poems and simple non-fiction books.

Mathematics

- Counting to 10 and beyond. Counting back from 10.
- Counting forwards and backwards from a given number.
- Know numbers and number names to 10.
- Find 1 more and 1 less than a number to 5, then 10.
- Use positional language.

Understanding the World

- To recognise different types of transport.
- Investigate light and dark.
- To talk about past and present events in their life and recall the sequence of a story.
- To be able to control the mouse.
- To use learning programs on the computers and ipads.

Expressive Art and Design

- To paint and print.
- To build using construction toys and draw what they have made.
- To be able to respond in a variety of ways to what they see and hear.
- To learn simple songs.
