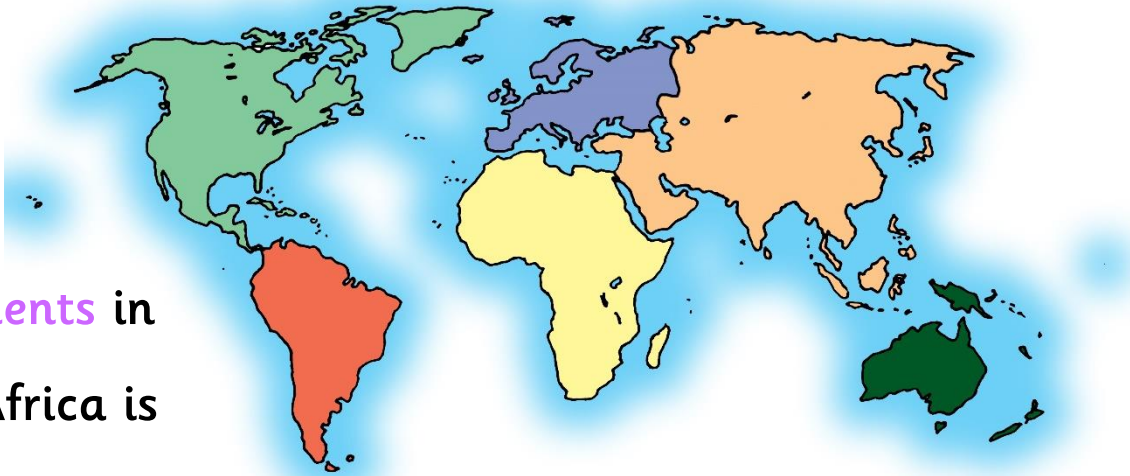


Africa

A lot of people think that Africa is a **country**, but it is not! Africa is a **continent**, which is a group of **countries**. There are 54 countries in Africa.

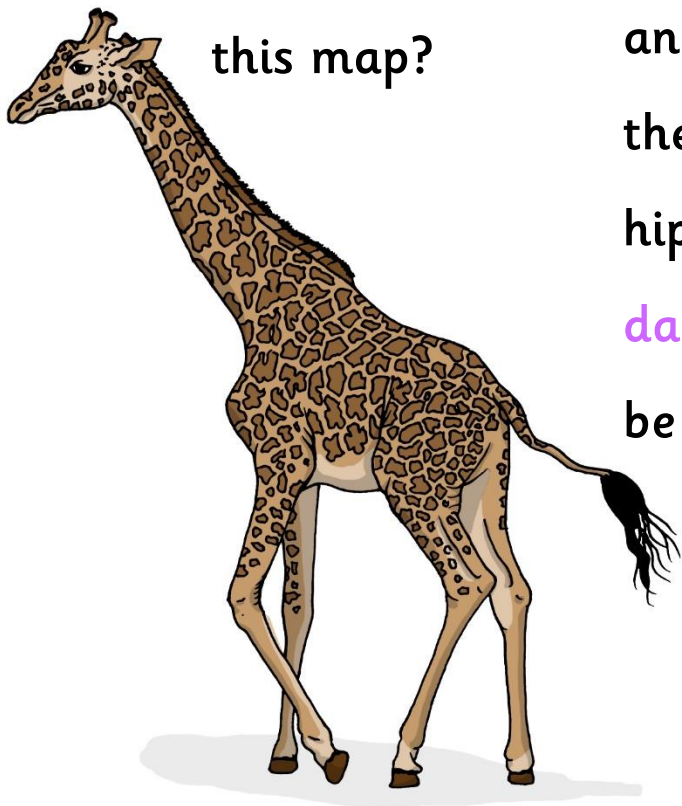
Where is it?

You might also find the largest **reptile** in the world, the Nile Crocodile, and the largest **primate**, the gorilla, in the African **jungles**.



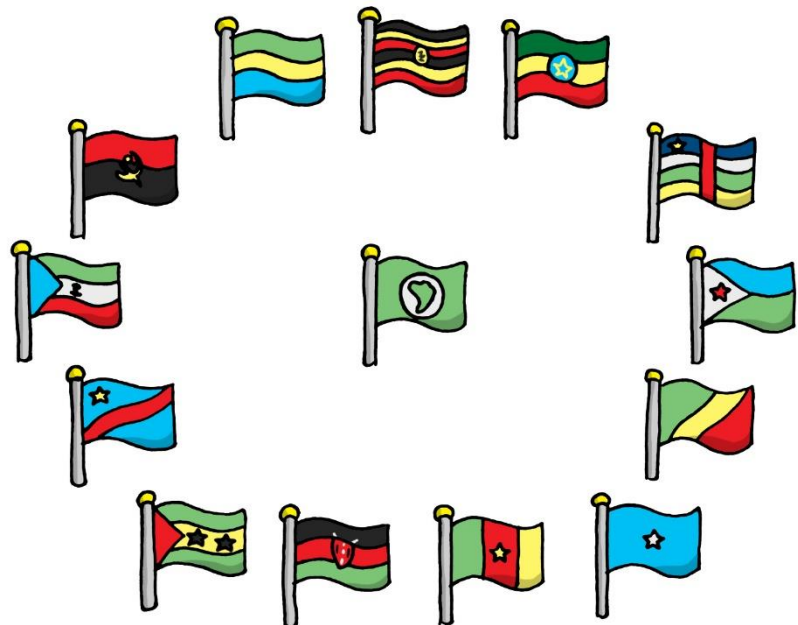
The Nile.

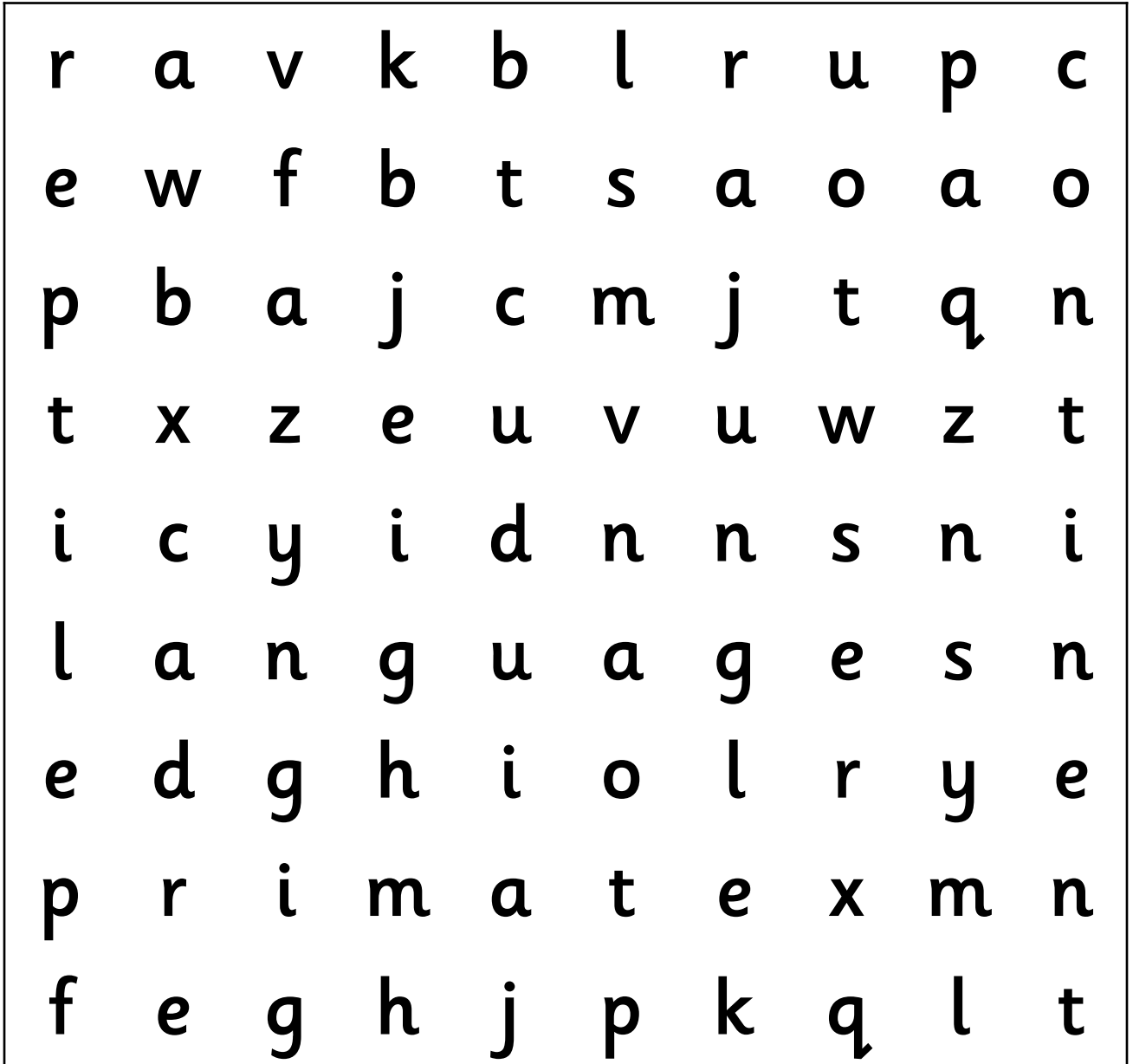

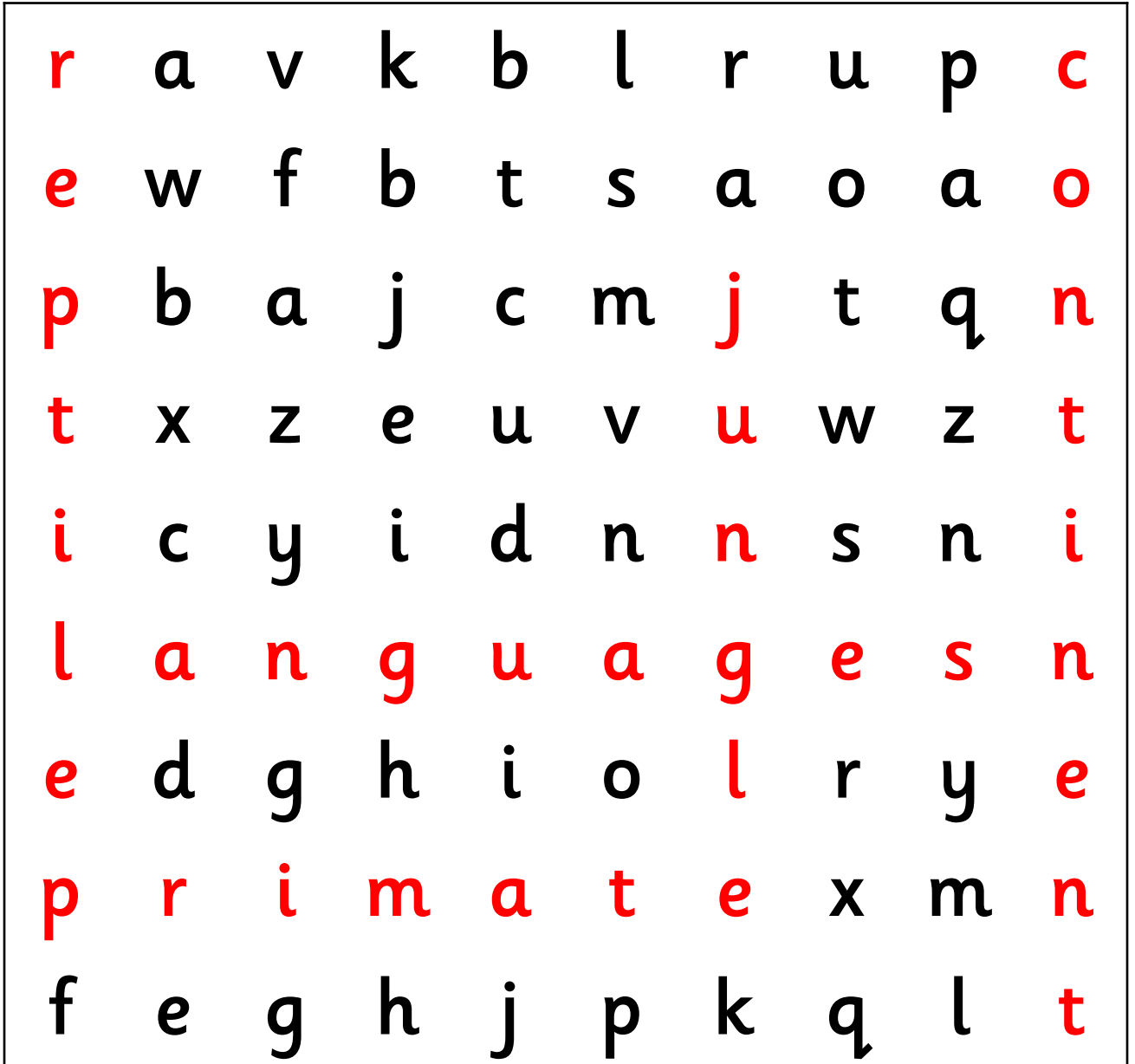
