PARENT/CARER CONTACT DETAILS

Due to GDPR rules we no longer print out data collections sheets for you to update. Thank you.

SPARE CLOTHES

We have a limited supply of spare clothes for girls, especially pants, socks and tights, if you have any of these at home which you no longer need, we would be happy for you to give them to school.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL DUE TO ILLNESS OR LATENESS

May we remind parents/carers that it is your responsibility to inform school by telephone if your child is absent. Please contact school on the first morning your child is absent for any reason including illness. Failure to contact school may result in absences being recorded in the register as unauthorised and could be considered as a failure to secure regular school attendance.

The School gates are open from 8.45am and it is the parents/carers responsibility to closely supervise their child in the playground until the school day starts at 8.55am. Please ensure the children stay off the grass, wooden activity trail and garden areas and encourage them to play sensibly whilst waiting to come into school.

If your child arrives at school after 9.05am they will receive a late mark on the class register. Lateness to school can be unsettling for children and disruptive for the class

SAFEGUARDING

To ensure our children's safety and to remove any risks, please do not leave young children or babies unattended in your car, whilst you drop off or collect other children from school.

BIKES & SCOOTERS

Reminder - Children must not use bikes and scooters whilst on the school grounds due to causing accidents with other pupils.
